An example Bill Title to solve a pressing need for Colorado communities and businesses

Bill Title: The Community and Corporate Clean Energy Options Investigation Act

Bill Summary: Over one million Coloradans live in cities with the stated goal of obtaining 100% of their electricity from renewable energy sources in the 2025 to 2035 timeframe. Many large Colorado businesses also have aggressive corporate renewable energy goals. These public and private entities currently have no way to reach their goals cost-effectively. This bill establishes a process – in the legislature, Governor's office, and/or Public Utilities Commission – to conduct an open and broadly inclusive stakeholder investigation into several possible approaches that would permit Colorado cities and businesses to reach their energy goals, and to identify the legislative and regulatory changes needed to implement the best identified solution.
